Aim and Objectives of the Seminar

Aim of the training course:

- to **reduce violent radicalization** and national extremism in the four Visegrad countries by **improving the impact and quality of national actions** promoting human rights and combating hate speech online and offline, and also by raising the quantity of these actions.

The objectives of the training sessions are:

- to **improve the management and coordination** of the national and regional (V4) campaigning communities and their online and offline actions,
- to **design and plan educational youth projects** that **raise awareness and develop competences** of young people in relation to combating hate speech and speaking up for human rights (based on the Bookmarks Manual),
- to **advocate for the importance and of combating hate speech** and speaking up for human rights to protect our democracies,
- to **design and plan regional activities** and actions in order to **strengthen the impact of the national and the European actions**.

Working language of the seminar will be English.

About the Participants

Participant Profile:

From each participating county there will be **2 national campaign coordinators** (youth workers) and **3 young volunteers** active and motivated in the field of human rights and democratic participation. Since a part of the program is dedicated to the educational activities, we would appreciate if at least one of the participants had an educational background or was willing act in the future as a trainer/facilitator or provider of educational activities.

Participant numbers:

The seminar will bring together 20 participants from Visegrad Group. We expect **5 participants per country**.

General requirements for participants:

- fluency in English (B2 level at least),
- age 18+,
- balanced national groups by gender,
- residence in V4 countries,
- commitment to work hard (8,5 hours per day at least) and full attendance during official sessions.

Preparation for the Training

Before the event, we will ask all participants **to share their experience via questionnaire with the No Hate Speech Campaign** in order to find out what your level of knowledge and experience is. Based on this, a content of the program will be adjusted to participants' needs with an aim to ensure a common appreciation of the process and to support the potential impact.

Items representing your country or regional/local food, music, objects, drinks etc.: During the training, every day on of the participating country will be responsible for 1 of the **cultural coffee breaks**. Therefore we encourage you to bring some products, objects, music etc. to share with the other participants

Your NGO materials: The training is also an opportunity to share with others information about your organization.

Prepare information about your involvement in No Hate Speech Campaign: Participants who were already involved in No hate speech campaign are asked to prepare their personal good practices from the campaign with an aim to share your experience. Those, who are new to the campaign, are asked to find out some information about the campaign in their country.

About Travel

Mean of travel:

- Public transport

Arrival and Departure:

- Arrival day: September 10th before 4 p.m.
- Departure day: September 15th after breakfast

Costs: Travel costs (up to eligible amount) will be reimbursed based on Erasmus+ travel distance calculator. **PLEASE DO NOT PURCHASE ANY TICKETS UNTIL YOU RECEIVE CONFIRMATION ON YOUR ITINERARY BY OUR LOGISTICS MANAGER.**

To be reimbursed for round trip travel, round trip documents must be submitted. We will need a copy of e-ticket showing the price paid or in case of a paper ticket, we will need an original for incoming and a copy for the return. Payment will be made by bank transfer.

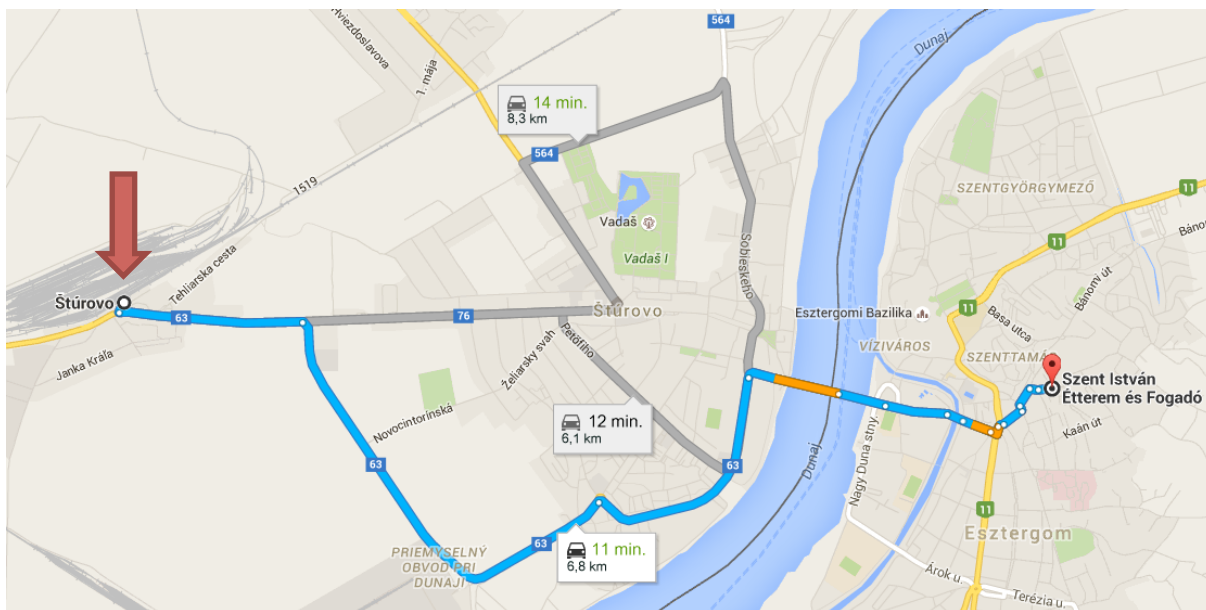
